ST. IMPERIAL reserved early, swung wide for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. WISE ESCAPE allowed to settle, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach the leaders in the stretch and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. SURELY SENT stumbled and bumped with CEE T CEE TWO at the start, was unhurried into the far turn, rallied between rivals to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole but was outfinished. THIS IS THAT pressed the pace outside CEE T CEE TWO, gained a slim lead from that rival on the far turn, made the pace to past the eighth pole, then weakened. HARBOR WIN stalked the pace three wide, made a run to try the leaders on the far turn and into the stretch, then gave way. LLEVATELO rated off the pace, had no response when asked. WARM MEMORIES tracked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. CEE T CEE TWO bumped at the start, set the pace under pressure along the rail into the far turn, then faltered.
