Footnotes

ALKAZABITO showed speed while angling over to the inside, vied for the lead into the stretch, then drew away when asked. MAREK'S CZECH off slowly, moved up quickly along the outside to vie for the lead three wide, continued to contest the pace with ALKAZABITO into the stretch after SWEETSTACK dropped back on the turn but was no match for that rival while clearly second best. CRIMSON CARL reserved early, advanced four wide around the turn to reach contention but couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. CANT STOP THE LITE broke poorly, moved up to track the leaders around the turn, then gave way. TRADER JOHN tracked the pace after breaking slowly, angled to the inside midway of the turn, then tired. GHOSTSONG was outrun. SWEETSTACK vied for the lead between horses into the turn and faltered. CIRCLING THE BASES off slowly, was done early. TINY TUNE LILY showed early foot, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
