EXTRA DRY MARTINI pressed the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the turn and continued on with good courage for the place while unable to match strides with the winner in the final sixteenth. GREY BOUQUET allowed to settle, passed tired rivals to gain the show. PROVEN HONOR chased the leaders three wide into the stretch and tired. MOTION DENIED saved ground to no avail. DYNA FLYER was outrun. HALO'S GEM reserved racing off the rail, checked when caught in tight in the stretch and failed to threaten. QUINCY LIGHT set the pace under pressure along the inside into the turn and faltered. PRINZ off slowly, saved ground and faded.
