NEED A LIGHT set the pace along the inside, then drew clear through the stretch under urging. TALKING ROSIE rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn and closed to prove second best. PINECALL was caught in tight at the start, steadied soon after entering the turn, then closed to gain the show while no threat to the top ones. SECRET SOCIETY chased the pace along the inside into the turn and gave way. SKIP SCHOOL prompted the pace off the rail into the turn and tired. SUNSHINE GLITTER chased the pace three wide into the stretch and faltered. PUNCHES TREAT showed little. MINNIE CON was outrun after stumbling badly at the start. BLINDFOLD showed early foot and faded.
