Footnotes

RATTLESNAKE RED unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. BALTIMORE SAINT reserved racing off the rail, eased in in the stretch, then rallied along the rail to reach the attending position just inside the sixteenth pole and continued on with good courage while being edged to the wire. SILVER DISTINCTION stalked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. REDWOOD MAN set the pace under pressure along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run while opening a clear lead, then gave way in the final sixteenth. PERFECTLY CRAZY outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. BOMBINO rated in striking position off the pace, lacked the needed response in the drive. HOPEFULLY LUCKY pressed the pace outside REDWOOD MAN into the stretch, then tired. COMMANDER TATE well placed while saving ground, faltered. JACKWAGON tracked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn and faded. KARMANOS was outrun while saving ground.
