Footnotes

SUPER FROLIC stalked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to catch TRUST N LUCK at the eighth pole and drew away under pressure. TRUST N LUCK hopped at the start, chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final eighth while continuing on with good courage for the place. UNBRIDELS KING stumbled at the start and bumped with SEA PLEASURE, outran TRUST N LUCK for the lead around the first turn, angled in to make the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch and weakened. THE NAME'S BOND reserved early, made a run four wide on the far turn to reach contention, then tired. GLOBAL PEACE failed to menace after being outrun early. POPPY'S IMAGE was no factor while saving ground. FORT SMITH up close early, faltered. SEA PLEASURE was outrun after being bumped at the start.
