SEA MIST outrun into the stretch, swung out and found her best stride late to just get up while fully extended. AMY 'N JILL chased the speed to the quarter pole three wide, dueled outside VIDLOCITY to midstretch, then drew off and just failed to last. VIDLOCITY made the pace off the rail to the quarter pole, dueled inside AMY 'N JILL to midstretch and gave way. MULTIPLICITY well placed three wide, weakened. VAGUE MEMORY hopped at the start, off slow, raced four wide and lacked a late response. GENTILLE ALOUETTE saved ground midpack, and tired.
