**Footnotes**

MS BROOKSKI reserved after breaking slowly, angled out in early stretch and rallied under pressure to be just up at the wire. REDOUBLED MISS rated off the pace, rallied four wide on the far turn, gained a slim lead in midstretch, then just failed to last. CIUDAD DE CARSON unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn, came out widest of all for the drive and was gaining slowly at the finish. STORMY FROLIC off slowly, saved ground, rallied along the inside to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't gain late. BOLD WORLD stalked the pace, moved to gain a slim lead outside BUCK FOR PAR leaving the far turn, then gave way late. BUCK FOR PAR tracked the pace along the rail, slipped through racing into the far turn to get her head in front, then tired in the stretch run. GRINDSTONE'S TINA failed to menace. HARRY'SBESTPROMISE stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the lead racing down the backstretch and into the far turn, then faltered. NO MYSTERY HERE set the pace off the rail into the far turn and faded. SEA SPAN hit the gate at the start, rated in striking position along the outside to nearing the far turn and stopped.
