SEA SHELL ANNIE rated off the pace along the inside, slipped through at the quarter pole, bumped with HERE'S THE QUEEN and stumbled then recovered and closed well to just get up for the victory. QUITE THE LIGHT bumped with TOUCH OF MAGIC at the start, steadied in between horses on the backstretch, raced up close four wide around the turn, took over at the head of the stretch and drifted out in the late stages just missing. LUV MY DINNER broke slowly, trailed while off the rail, rallied belatedly and was caught in tight in deep stretch. TOUCH OF MAGIC bumped with QUITE THE LIGHT and steadied shortly after the start, reserved off the pace along the inside, steadied again leaving the turn to avoid the fallen horse then lacked the needed late response. HOMETOWN PRINCESS vied for the lead, four wide around the turn, held a brief lead at the head of the stretch and gave way. RANDOM ANNIE allowed to settle, veered out at the quarter pole to avoid the fallen horse and failed to menace. BON BON PRINCESS vied for the lead, three wide on the turn and tired. HERE'S THE QUEEN lugged out while vying for the lead while off the rail, clipped heels at the quarter pole and fell. There was a stewards inquiry into the quarter pole and late stretch. No action was taken.
