THATS MARIA stalked the pace, then rallied under pressure to be up late. SILVER LOVE showed good speed along the inside and continued on gamely while unable to resist the winner. TILTALADY reserved early, raced three wide around the turn and outfinished the others. BELLA APPROVAL was no threat after being squeezed back early. R. C. ANGEL raced four wide around the turn and tired. NOMO QUESTIONS, off slowly, was bumped early and faltered in the drive. LAYLIN (VEN) hesitated at the start and was not a factor. GRAND MERCEDES lugged in through the stretch run while being outrun. PLEASANT TIP was never close. MI REVIEW was caught in tight at the start, bumped early and faded.
