Footnotes

ENORMISO chased the pace four wide into the stretch, then rallied under pressure to be up late. VLAMINCK showed speed off the rail, edged clear in midstretch but couldn't hold off the winner late. SMART COLE showed brief speed, chased VLAMINCK three wide around the turn and gave way. WILD RATE unhurried after breaking poorly, advanced along the inside around the turn, altered course outside rivals in the stretch for racing room and closed with a belated rally. GIVEMETHIRTYDAYS reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed ground late without threatening. BACKSTAGE LOUNGE tracked the pace around the turn and tired. BRAVE APACHE showed early foot, raced four wide around the turn and tired. SOLE RUNNER checked from tight quarters soon after the start, rushed up five wide to reach contention racing into the turn, then faded.
