Footnotes

CATCH THE BEAT reserved racing along the inside, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to gain command just inside the eighth pole, then drew away under urging. MANDATED TO WIN allowed to settle, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out and closed to prove best of the rest while unable to match strides with the winner. SMOKIN ALI tracked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead entering the stretch, maintained that advantage to the eighth pole, then gave way. LEMON FEVER pressed the pace outside ITS ENTERTAINMENT, drew clear from that rival on the far turn while easing to the inside, then tired in the drive. FANDANGO STEPS failed to menace after being outrun early. SOIREE STUNNER was no factor while racing three wide. JIMMY'S TOO BLUE rated off the pace, faltered. ITS ENTERTAINMENT set the pace under pressure along the inside to the far turn, then was fading when she bumped the rail in the stretch.
