WATCHFULL racing along the rail, steadied in behind KIPPER QUILA leaving the backstretch, dropped back around the turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to take over inside the eighth pole, then was taken in hand late. SWEEPING vied for the lead, edged clear in midstretch but was no match for the winner while holding the place. SUGAR N SPICE well placed after breaking slowly, couldn't gain in the stretch run. SUPERBOWL PICC chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command three wide on the turn, then weakened in the drive. OCEAN AIR was outrun. KIPPER QUILA vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch and tired.
