U SO BAD taken in hand to save ground, angled four wide midway of the far turn and rallied under steady pressure to be up in time. ELITE MERCEDES set the pace along the inside, drew clear around the far turn and just failed to last. MEGACLES rated off the pace, advance three wide around the far turn but couldn't gain late. B L'S APPEAL never far back, advanced into the attending position on the far turn but had no late response. WHATA BRAINSTORM, four wide around the far turn, rallied belatedly while drifting out in midstretch. BOLD MERIDIAN drifted out entering the first turn and lacked the needed rally. SIGN OF FIRE clipped ELLS END's heels when forced out by BOLD MERIDIAN on the first turn and was not a factor. ELLS END raced wide around the first turn and was outrun. THE MIGHTY ATOM chased the pace along the rail and faded. SHARP SWORD chased the pace into the far turn and stopped.
