PLAN OF ATTACK bumped with DIG FOR DINNER at the start, stalked the pace into the stretch, moved to gain command nearing the eighth pole and drew off while in hand. DIG FOR DINNER unhurried after stumbling when bumped from both sides at the start, raced three wide around the turn, swung out for the drive and closed to be up for the place while never a threat to the winner. TALL HONOR off slowly, tracked the leaders into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. RIVER MAAM reserved after breaking slowly and bumping DIG FOR DINNER in the rear at the start, tired in the drive. MISS ABERDEEN chased the leaders three wide around the turn and faltered. CAPOTA showed speed along the inside into the stretch and faded. THIRTEEN TREASURES lunged at the start and unseated her rider.
