Footnotes

SEA MECKE stalked the pace, moved to gain the lead approaching the quarter pole, then drew off under a hand ride. BOBS TIEBREAKER unhurried early, angled out on the far turn and closed to prove best of the rest. CARTOUCHE reserved early, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. PRINCE OF SONG set the pace outside IMMORTAL WINK, moved to the inside on the far turn after that rival dropped back, then couldn't stay with the winner and tired in the drive. STARSHIP SCOTT steadied to avoid running up on rivals on the first turn, stalked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. IMMORTAL WINK prompted the pace along the inside to the far turn, then faded. CHINSEGUT BAY was outrun.
