Footnotes

EL KINGDOM stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside BERNIE THE MAESTRO at the top of the stretch to gain the lead, drifted in front of that rival at the eighth pole, then drew away. BERNIE THE MAESTRO set the pace racing just off the rail, came out a bit entering the stretch leaving room for EL KINGDOM, then was being outfinished when steadied in behind that rival at the eighth pole, recovered and held the place. TANNERSVILLE unhurried early, closed with a mild rally between horses for the show. FLY BY PHIL stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. BIM BAM rated in striking position off the pace, angled four wide on the far turn to track the leaders into the stretch, then tired. JOHN JOHNNY JAK chased the pace off the rail into the stretch but had nothing left. CONCORDE'S FURY allowed to settle, saved ground and failed to menace. FLATTER THIS reserved off the pace, faltered in the drive. GREEN LITE SPECIAL was outrun. BARRA D'ORO raced four wide and faded. STRONG STAR was through after a half mile. MIMITO BOY was done early. The rider of BERNIE THE MAESTRO lodged an objection against the rider of EL KINGDOM for alleged interference at the eighth pole. The stewards determined the incident had no effect on the outcome and the claim of foul was not allowed.
