ANCHORWOMAN chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and edged away under urging. PATIENT APPROVAL unhurried early, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and rallied to prove best of the rest. MEZUMAN showed speed along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run and gave way. PRINCESS FOR A DAY rated off the pace after being steadied in the early going, had no late response. CAT FERRAD reserved off the pace, advanced along the inside around the turn to loom a threat, then tired in the final eighth. POP'S GEM off slowly, failed to menace. IWASPAIDLATE pressed the pace between horses around the turn and faltered. BODY HEAT was through early. AZISA was not a factor.
