WILDCAT FORMATION set the pace along the inside, drew clear in midstretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. PHIL'S FIRST rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied for the place. DOINGIT N LOVINGIT stalked the pace three wide, dropped back around the far turn and into the stretch, then closed to be up for the show. MAJESTIC TRAIN stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. CUNAGUARO stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch, then faltered. BALLY DUFF BRIDGE off slowly, was not a factor. TARZANITO was done early and eased in the final eighth.
