RUN SMART ONE rated off the pace, rallied four wide to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then maintained his advantage to the wire under urging. GREAT BLADE unhurried early, raced five wide around the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. STAGE DELI outrun early, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch, then flattened out. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR set the pace off the rail to midway of the far turn, then tired. CRACKLIN well placed early, dropped back racing into the far turn and failed to menace thereafter. YOMBO MAUGERE was not a factor. HIGH BRASS chased the pace, angled in on the backstretch to save ground around the far turn while continuing to chase the pace, then faltered in the drive. GONE STRAIGHT chased the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faded.
