INVOICE chased the pace, slipped through along the rail to take over entering the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. PALACE set the pace racing off the rail and continued on with good courage to hold the place while being outfinished by the winner. PRETTY WOMEN well placed while saving ground, didn't do enough late. CANNON WHIRL outrun early, steadied in traffic on the turn, advanced along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. TALENTED BET raced wide throughout and was not a threat. LINEAR MARK failed to menace. SUNMIST chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command three wide on the turn, then tired. CAPRICIOUSNESS was outrun while racing three wide. TUFF PRINCESS pulled up lame soon after the start.
