PEACE OFFERING tracked the pace, angled outside the leaders leaving the turn, rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and drew away under urging. VELVET HOPE rated off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, rallied to take over in the stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the rest. MYSTERIOUS TIMES bumped with RED RUFFLE at the start, chased the pace around the turn and tired. TUFF MUFFIN off slowly, raced along the rail and failed to be a factor. CONVEYOR'S ANGEL showed speed along the inside into the stretch and faltered. RED RUFFLE bumped MYSTERIOUS TIMES at the start and unseated her rider.
