STORM FORCAST stalked the pace, rallied three wide to take over midway of the far turn and opened a commanding lead, then was under a hand ride to remain well clear to the wire. SILVER SASSY unhurried early, saved ground around the far turn, angled out and closed to prove best of the others while unable to get to the winner. MEGAFLEET allowed to settle, raced three wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals for the show. FAIR MISS GRACE tracked the leaders into the far turn and tired. LISA THE GREAT was not a factor. DIRTYLITTLESECRETS moved up outside RODS MISTRESS to vie for the lead down the backstretch and into the far turn, then faltered. RODS MISTRESS showed speed along the rail, responded when headed on the backstretch, contested the pace to midway of the far turn and faded.
