TO HEIR IS HUMAN stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside DIXIE FROLIC to gain the lead just past the eighth pole, then drew clear. LITE UP THE STAGE chased the pace three wide, moved up to engage DIXIE FROLIC on the far turn, then wore that rival down for the place while being outfinished by the winner. UNBRIDLED FUTURE never far back, angled four wide on the far turn and finished willingly to just miss the place while unable to stay with the winner. DIXIE FROLIC set the pace off the rail, responded when challenged on the far turn, then weakened in the final eighth. IN SPEIGHT OF IT wanted to settle, raced five wide around the far turn and lacked a rally. SUPAH ALEX off slowly, was not a factor. EL SIMON was outrun. RAINBOW CRUISE chased the pace four wide into the far turn and faded.
