Footnotes

KAISER'S D'LIGHT set the pace off the rail into the stretch, then drew off when asked. VALID DISTINCTION pressed the pace outside KAISER'S D'LIGHT into the far turn, then was no match for that rival while holding the place. PATIENCE GAME tracked the leaders off the rail, angled to the inside on the far turn, then couldn't keep pace with the winner or gain on the runner-up. FLY AWAY MARIJA hit the gate at the start, then checked from inside MAJOR MASABI soon after entering the first turn and never threatened. SACRED CLASS broke awkwardly, tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and tired. MAJOR MASABI up close early, steadied in behind rivals soon after entering the first turn and was through after a half mile. DAIKATANA was done early. CAROLTEEN unhurried early, tried to bear out racing down the backstretch and was pulled up.
