THE WINTER QUEEN outran I CAN SEE MY DREAM for the lead around the first turn, set the pace in hand along the inside into the stretch, then drew away when asked. I CAN SEE MY DREAM chased the winner off the rail into the stretch but was no match for that rival while proving best of the rest. GRAND DIXIE forced AVADAY in entering the first turn, tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch, then tired. AVADAY rated off the pace after being forced in entering the first turn, faltered in the drive. SLAM RUNNER stalked the pace off the rail into the far turn, then faded. FERRETERA was tripped up by IDALYA'S DREAM entering the first turn and unseated her rider. IDALYA'S DREAM clipped heels with AVADAY entering the first turn and unseated her rider. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY, GRAND DIXIE WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SEVENTH FOR CAUSING INTERFERENCE TO SEVERAL RIVALS ENTERING THE FIRST TURN.
