VIVACE was reserved early,rallied four wide on the turn then drew off in hand. SEA HORSE, outrun early,angled four wide on the turn then closed late for the place. TRUE VALAY dueled three wide into upper stretch and drifted out while weakening. BET THE SIGHTS battled between horses for a half and tired. STORMY DO set or forced the pace along the rail to the turn and gave way. OROCOPIO failed to mount a serious rally. MIDNIGHT COYOTE showed only brief speed.
