SIBERGACE reserved early, rallied mildly to best the others. SKIRTS A FLYING chased the pace and weakened. MAMATASS, off poorly, passed tired rivals. COOKIES N CREAM was no factor after breaking poorly. SASS N' CLASS broke slowly and was outrun. CUT THE CARDS showed early foot along the rail and faded. FIRST IN LINE was never close after swerving in at the start. THIS ONE CAN ZIP was through early.
