STATELY CHARACTER outrun after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied under pressure to be up late. THIS ONES FOR PHIL chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner in the final seventy yards. MARCH TWELTH chased the pace into the stretch and tired. CODE RUNNER steadied along the inside midway of the first turn, dropped back to last racing down the backstretch and never threatened. SABI SABI showed speed off the rail into the far turn and faltered. GRAND CENTRAL stumbled at the start, showed speed along the rail to the far turn, then faded.
