### Footnotes

ROMAN SCORE set the pace along the inside, drew off around the far turn and into the stretch, then was kept to pressure to maintain her advantage to the wire. LADY MYRKA rated off the pace after stumbling at the start, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach the attending position but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. MYSTICAL MARY M. unhurried early, saved ground and gained the show while never a threat to the top ones. STING CUT was not a factor. LADY MOSS was outrun. GENERATIONS Y chased the pace along the inside into the far turn and faltered. ANNIA'S LOVE chased the pace off the rail into the far turn, then faded and was eased in the final eighth.
