Footnotes

ALLEY OOP OOP stalked the pace off the rail, moved to take over at the top of the stretch, then was all out to prevail. ALL KNIGHT tracked the pace, made a run three wide to join the leaders on the far turn, was outmoved in midstretch but continued on willingly for the place while unable to catch the winner. AMERICAN DOE reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up for the show. NOTIMETOKILL set the pace along the rail, responded when headed by ALLEY OOP OOP at the top of the stretch, then weakened in the final eighth. STAY RED tracked the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then gave way. WHISPER ONTHE WIND stalked the pace to nearing the stretch and tired. IMPERIAL ROBYN was no factor after breaking poorly. NEWSPAPER BOY broke poorly, rushed up while rank under restraint early, then was checked twice on the first turn to avoid running up on NOTIMETOKILL, settled down to stalk the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faded.
