DONDE ESTARAS reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, angled three wide on the turn, rallied to take over entering the stretch, then drew off under urging. ICANSEECLEARLY tracked the pace, raced three wide on the turn and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. TECHNICAL QUESTION outrun early, angled wide for the stretch run and closed to gain the show while just missing the place. BRUNSWICK BELLE vied for the lead along the inside to the top of the stretch and gave way. ERIN OF WICKLOW vied for the lead outside BRUNSWICK BELLE to nearing the stretch, then tired. RIDING rated off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and faltered. SILVER TOUCH saved ground to no avail. FLY BIRDIE FLY showed some early foot and faded.
