Footnotes

KAMINSKI reserved off the pace after being caught in tight at the start, swung out leaving the turn, rallied to catch STRONG FIRE just inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. STRONG FIRE chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the turn, responded when headed by KAMINSKI inside the eighth pole, then gave way grudgingly late. EMPEROR'S TUNE bumped hard with PULPO at the start, showed speed along the inside, responded when headed by STRONG FIRE on the turn, stayed with that rival to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. BLUE KING steadied in the chute, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but had no response when asked. SLEW DEM was never close after being checked to avoid PULPO soon after the start. MAR BRAVO showed early foot and faltered. PULPO rated off the pace after being steadied when bumped soundly by EMPEROR'S TUNE at the start, raced four wide around the turn and faded.
