COPPERGOLDN'SILVER off slow, moved up to rate off the pace while off the rail, rallied to gain the lead inside the eight pole and drew off while kept to the task. JEB'S SONG sprinted to an early lead off the rail, and gave way inside the eighth pole. DIXIE TRIXIE chased the speed, moved into contention outside JEB'S SONG on the turn, and failed to sustain her bid. ROYAL FORUM off slow, in good position along the rail, lacked a late response. NEEDNOINTRODUCTION showed brief foot. WILD BLUEBERRY hesitated at the start, trailed, then swung widest for the drive and was outrun. MASARA KEY was well placed and tired. ON ACCOUNTING OF showed little.
