I'M ALL GUSSIED UP well placed while saving ground, rallied along the inside to take over entering the stretch, drifted out while opening a clear lead, then was fully extended to last over INLET. The latter, unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied along the inside through the drive and was gaining on the winner at the finish. ROMACA rated off the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but had no late response. SASSY AFFAIR outrun early, raced four wide on the far turn and passed tired rivals. REGAL MISS off slowly, was reserved off the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn to reach contention, then flattened out. LUCKYANUNOIT chased the pace, moved to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then tired in the drive. AZUCAA bobbled at the start, made the pace off the rail into the far turn, faltered and was eased in the final eighth. OKAY RENEE rank and steadied several times in the early going, tracked the pace for a half mile, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
