MYSTERIOUS LIGHT stalked the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the far turn, rallied to catch PARISIAN TRIP in early stretch and drew off under a vigorous hand ride. ZLATKA (PER) off slowly, was reserved off the pace after being steadied in the run to the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. MORALAP stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. PARISIAN TRIP chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over racing down the backstretch and opened a clear lead, then faltered in the drive. SANTASLITTLEHELPER was not a factor. MAGNOLIA LIGHT was outrun. RIVER THAMES set the pace along the rail to midway of the backstretch, then stopped abruptly and was eased leaving the far turn.
