DEPUTY MAC was well handled while setting the pace, drew clear in midstretch and proved best under steady urging. MT OLYMPUS, reserved early, rallied in the drive and was up for the place. DANCE THE BALLADO, stalked the pace, steadied entering the far turn losing good position, then came on to best the rest. RED'S COUNT, unhurried early, had a mild response in the drive. CHRI'S DANCER chased the pace, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then tired. RIGHT IN LINE saved ground to no avail. ARTEMIO stalked the pace and faltered. OCEANIC HERO was no factor after breaking poorly. ROYAL BART showed little.
