Footnotes

DANCING IN GERARDA rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and won going away. MONTE VALLO LIGHT chased the pace into the stretch and closed to gain the place while being outfinished by the winner. SNUCK OUT vied for the lead outside SLICK SWORD to inside the eighth pole and gave way. SLICK SWORD vied for the lead along the inside to past the eighth pole and tired. TIGERVALLY up close early, saved ground and faltered. COOKIES IN THE JAR off slowly, failed to menace. HIP TWENTYFIVE was not a factor. GENERAL LEDGER was outrun. JOLLY GOOD GUY showed little after breaking poorly. CRUZAN REPRIZE reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
