DRY MARTINI stalked the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over entering the stretch and drew off under urging. GOLD NATIVE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner in the drive. HELLO MECKE unhurried after being pinched back at the start, passed tired rivals for the show. EL LOBO set the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left for the drive. SPIKEAVELLIAN chased the pace into the stretch and faltered. SIR OSO was outrun. THE MOVE MAN showed little.
