Footnotes

MELODY FOR MARIA rushed four wide to challenge for command on the turn, gained a short advantage leaving the quarter pole, angled down to the rail while well clear near midstretch and was not menaced thereafter. HOLIDAY ASHLEY was shuffled near the rear of pack in the opening furlong, saved ground on the bend then rallied belatedly. STOKES BRIDGE prompted the pace into the stretch and weakened. TINY WINGS raced three wide in the first flight, held to the stretch and gave way. OUR PEE CHEE steadied from behind horses nearing the three eighths pole and was no threat thereafter. COOL EM OFF set the pace from the rail to the quarter pole and tired. WAD A LUCK was not a factor. COME ON GIRL raced wide while well back throughout. ADURING flashed brief speed when hustled out of the gate, tired badly and was eased to the wire.
