SCULPTOR controlled the pace while saving ground, settled into the stretch with a comfortable advantage while taken slightly off the rail then held sway under steady urging. DANCE PAL saved ground into the stretch and outlasted the others. LOS VICTORS saved ground on the turn then rallied mildly. ULTERIOR MOTIVE saved ground while well placed behind the early leader but had no closing response. PURPLE DESERT raced wide and had no rally. IM HAVING A BALL was never a serious factor. GORLOCK lagged far back. EARLY CHRISTMAS prompted the winner's pace and faltered. WHATS A WERBLIN was always outrun.
