Footnotes

RAKE AND A RAMBLER tracked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. PISTOL RULES set the pace along the inside to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the others. QUEEN'S KNIGHT unhurried after being bothered at the start, raced three wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals for the show. SAINT JUDE chased the winner to nearing the stretch, then tired. FIORE DICAMPO broke to the outside at the start and was never a factor. TIME FOR TUTT off slowly, was outrun. WATCH ROCK rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered. WELL TALENTED was through after a half mile. INDIAN FROM SKY rank and checked along the inside on the first turn, was done early.
