Footnotes

DOCTOR LENNY was first to show in front following an alert beginning then was reserved off the early leader while saving ground, engaged Morgans Boy to assume control before six furlongs then drew off with authority while kept under pressure through the final furlong. MORGANS BOY stalked the pace, moved to a short lead between calls nearing the three eighths pole, could not resist the winner when challenged on the final turn but remained second best. GONE STRAIGHT never far back, steadied briefly approaching the three eighths pole, remained within easy striking distance into the stretch and weakened. VINI VIDI VINCI, away slowest, made a mild run to contention while wide on the second turn, quickly flattened out and fell back steadily thereafter. COMPRISE made a three wide run at the leaders nearing the quarter pole but faltered badly down the stretch. VEGETARIAN SOLDIER set the early pace but was through before six furlongs. WISE ESCAPE lost contact with the field into the stretch and was eased across the wire.
