B L'S DANZIG showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew clear under urging. EL QUIXOTE pressed the pace outside B L'S DANZIG, then couldn't match strides with that rival in the drive while continuing on with good courage to edge for the place. THANKS DUBYA rated off the pace after breaking slowly, steadied in tight quarters entering the turn, angled out and made a run three wide at the leaders leaving the turn, then gave way. GOTTTCHA GOLD tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. UNIVERSAL STORY failed to menace after hitting the gate at the start. JET PROPULSION was outrun. GEORGE'S DANCE chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded.
