ASPETUCK HILL chased the pace four wide, moved to take over on the turn, then drew off under urging. SMALLNESS chased the pace, made a run between horses to reach near even terms for command but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the rest. SICILIAN HONOR chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. NORMA CLAIRE failed to menace after bobbling at the start. MEADOW SKIPPER was never a threat after breaking poorly. BURNING BELLE was not a factor. TIGER QUEEN rated off the pace, faltered leaving the turn. HICKORY GRAY sprinted to a clear lead along the rail, made the pace into the turn, then had nothing left. ROARING RIVER reserved off the pace, faded. TRIPPELING was outrun. MINIGIRL showed little.
