DANDYS ESSENCE chased the pace, rallied three wide to take over on the turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. SHE'S A SLEEPER pressed the pace outside DREWS HONOREE to nearing the stretch, then tired. MINISTREL LISA failed to menace. DREWS HONOREE showed speed along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. CULTURE SHOCK was not a factor. OH MANDIE tracked the pace around the turn and faded. ALTAMAR was through early. MARILLA was outrun.
