Footnotes

BALTIMORE SAINT made a strong run leaving the backstretch to overtake the leader and draw well clear midway on the second turn, settled into the stretch with a long lead then held on despite drifting near the end. L'S LEGACY rallied four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. CLAWER broke slow, angled out while advancing into the stretch and continued on nicely to the end. CASH US NOW raced forwardly, advanced to striking position into the stretch but could not sustain the necessary bid near the end. MR. IZZY saved ground, struck the inner rail on the far turn and never threatened. SUPAH SECRET had brief speed and tired. STACK THE DECK checked off behind Emocao in the opening furlong, came back out to re-challenge that rival on the opening bend, edged clear midway the backstretch but had nothing left after six furlongs. EMOCAO showed in front early, checked briefly inside Cash Us Now while tiring nearing the far turn, stopped badly, pulled up and was vanned off. A claim of foul by the rider of Cash Us Now against the winner for alleged interference approaching the far turn was disallowed.
