Footnotes

PYRITE RAIN reserved racing along the inside, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. CELESTIAL STAR rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied inside PYRITE RAIN to be up for the place while being outfinished by that rival. NATURELLE'S WAY unhurried early, rallied four wide around the far turn to gain a slim lead in the stretch but was edged to the wire late. SUPAH JACKIE stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the leaders on the far turn, then tired. RUSSIAN NOTE vied for the lead outside RUSLANOVA, edged away from that rival on the far turn, then gave way in the final eighth. RUSLANOVA vied for the lead along the rail into the far turn and faltered. PHILYMENA raced in striking position into the far turn, then faded. LINEUPONTHEVEE was outrun. THEBEATGOESON dropped back racing down the backstretch, then was being pulled up on the far turn when she ran into the outside hedge and unseated her rider.
