Footnotes

SUNSATONAL reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and rallied under pressure to be up late. KEENE ROAD bumped with DEFINITELY TRUE at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, drew clear on the turn but couldn't resist the winner late. DEFINITELY TRUE bumped with KEENE ROAD at the start, raced with the pace to past midway of the turn, then couldn't stay with the winner and weakened in the drive. JET PROP unhurried after breaking slowly, steadied in traffic on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed with a belated rally. MAX'S BEAU rated off the pace, saved ground around the turn, angled out and didn't do enough late. LIQUEUR showed speed along the rail to midway of the turn and tired. ARTAX COLLECTOR showed brief speed and faltered. THE MOVE MAN tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and faded.
