Footnotes

MAREK'S CZECH reserved early, angled outside the leaders in the stretch, then rallied to be up in the final strides. WAT was chasing the pace when steadied in behind HONEST PAUL nearing the end of the backstretch, continued to chase that rival into the stretch and closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. HONEST PAUL pressed the pace outside MAGIC FORMULA, came in forcing that rival into UNDEFEATED while moving to gain the lead entering the turn, made the pace to deep stretch and weakened. TWISTED PRINCE reserved racing along the rail, was checked in behind UNDEFEATED nearly unseating his rider soon after entering the turn, then tired. STORMING TAYLOR tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and faltered. MAGIC FORMULA showed speed off the rail, was taken up when forced into UNDEFEATED entering the turn and failed to recover. LA MOTONETA off slowly, was never a factor. UNDEFEATED was racing along the inside when he was bumped and hit the rail entering the turn causing his rider to lose his irons, then faded. Following a stewards inquiry HONEST PAUL was disqualified and placed eighth for interference to several rivals entering the turn.
